The goals of camp are training, having fun, enhancing relationships and building skills! In the past, camp has included test sessions for those wanting to work on Wag It Games titles. We know "test" sessions can be stressful so this year we have eliminated test sessions and opted for a more relaxed approach for those interested in working towards titles.

Camp Cards will be issued for each dog. Teams can work on training, playing and practicing activities in various workshops. If during workshops the dog can perform an activity, course oR game as required your instructor can record it on the dog's camp card.

If a dog completes a test's requirement it may be used for one leg* towards a title. It takes 3 legs* at a level to earn each of the three base titles.

*Completing the requirements of a test is called earning a leg.

- WAG ONE Novice level title
- WAG TWO Skilled level title
- WAG THREE Proficient level title

Additional advanced titles are also available. See the title chart on the Wag It Games website.

Dogs must be registered with Wag It Games to earn titles. **Dogs may be registered after camp.** Registration is done on the Wag It Games website and is good for the life of the dog.
